WHITE

Chenin Blanc False Bay, South Africa. £26.50 /4.50 /5.50 /9.00

Dry but with notes of apple and a touch of creamy lemon. With a lovely depth of flavour, this is a great all-rounder.

Pinot Grigio Terrazze Della Luna, Trentino Italy £28 /4.80 /6.80/9.50

Squeaky clean, dry and delicately fruity with plenty of life.

Sauvignon Blanc the Cloud Factory, Marlborough, New Zealand. £31 /5.50/ 6.80/ 10.50

Bursting with green nettle aromas and with tropical notes on the palate, this is sappy, clean and delicious.

Picpoul de Pinet Duc de Morny”Caves de l'ormarine Coteaux du Languedoc, France. £32

vigorous, dry and bouncing with freshness, this is perfect with fish and shellfish.

Chablis Domaine la Motte, Famille Michaud, France. £ 49

An old favourite of classic style, chalky dry, incisive and clear on the palate.

Pouilly Fume Domaine Blondelet, Loire Valley, France. £56

Bone dry with nettle green aromas and a characteristic hint of gun flint, this is just a stone throw from Sancerre

ROSE

Zinfandel Rose Big Top, California. £24.50/ 4.50 /5.70 /8.50

Strawberry ice cream on the nose supported by a bright, berry fruited palate, with a medium dry finish.

Cotes Du Rhone Rose Les Cerisiers, France. £32 /5.50 /6.80 /10.50

Pale and elegant, it combines something of the depth of flavour of the Rhône with the delicate structure of Provence, it is the best of both regions in the same bottle.

RED

Shiraz False Bay, Old School, South Africa. £27.50/ 4.50/ 6.50/ 9.00

Full yet elegant with brambly notes and well balanced with red and black fruit characters.

Côte du Rhône, La Chapelle de Marin, France. £33 /5.50 /6.80/ 9.80

A Chunky, soft red with up-front fruit, warm spice and real depth.

Malbec Molinillo, Uco Valley, Mendoza, Argentina. £31/ 5.45 /6.70/ 9.60

Plenty of fresh blueberry fruit on the nose with a touch of floral. Juicy and full on the palate with abundant ripe berry fruit.

Pinot Noir Novas Gran Reserva, Valle de Casablanca, Chile, Organic. £35

This wine has a delicious summer fruit character and a gentle cranberry grip with a note of spice from barrel ageing.

Rioja – Crianza Cerro Añon, Bodegas Olarra, Spain. £35

Full, traditional and satisfying with ripe, Tempranillo fruit and a good lick of oak spice.

Gigondas, Domaine la Font de Notre Dame, Southern Rhône, France. £51.00

This is serious and brooding, a red of weight and depth from one of the finest communes in the southern part of the valley. Big, balanced and beautiful.

Champagne & Sparkling

Adnams Fizz, France. £15.00

Stone fruit aromas of peach and nectarine with mineral and citrus notes, well rounded with good length.

Prosecco Spumante, Lunetta Veneto, Italy £33 /6.50

Dry and refreshing with a brisk fizz and delicate notes of crisp fruit.

Crémant de Limoux, “Les Graiménous”, Brut, Domaine J. Laurens, France. £ 45

A delicious and serious alternative to champagne; dry with outstanding purity of fruit and refined balance.

Gremillet Selection Brut NV £69

A family-owned and run estate, Gremillet make a fully flavoured, riper style of Champagne with peachy fruit and brioche notes balanced by a fresh, citrus finish
